Notable Features of the Curriculum 2016/17

- Pupils are taught in 2 bands (P and Q)
- There are 4 groups in P band and 2 groups in Q band.
- 7L Nurture pathway for 14 students.
 - Pupils study 7 hours of English, 6 of Maths and 3 of Spanish (No French) along with 2 hours of Drama – all other allocations as Year 7 model.
- Year 8 curriculum model has changes to allow for specialism in either French or Spanish – one language is selected at the end of Year 7.
- 8Q1 and Q1 have an hour extra English and Maths in place of 2 Spanish hours.
- Years 9 & 10 have additional Maths, Science & English time to reflect the additional demands of the courses
- Year 9 have dropped to 3 options rather than 4 – option blocks restructured to increase Ebacc uptake.
- There are a small number of pupils who have dropped to 3 options in Year 11 to allow for 4 hours extra core intervention in English & Mathematics.
